## **Board Resolution No. 317** Series of 2011

## Ordering Submission of Proofs of Compliance with 40-Hour Construction Safety and Health Course

Whereas, under Board Resolution No. 144, series of 2011, the PCAB required (a) proprietors or AMOs of new license applicants; (b) applicants for change of AMO; and (c) proprietors or AMOs of applicants for upgrading of license category to submit on or before 30 June 2011 proof of completion of the 40-hour Construction Safety and Health Course for Site Safety Officers conducted by Construction Manpower Development Foundation, Inc. (CMDF) and other Bureau of Working Condition (BWC) accredited training organizations;

Whereas, a number of renewing applicants for CFY 2011-2012 have difficulty in complying with the said construction safety and health course due to lack of slots/fully booked schedule because of growing number of attendees;

Whereas, affected renewing applicants will be denied license renewal and thus will cause disruption in their construction contracting activities;

NOW, THEREFORE, based on the foregoing premises, the Board RESOLVED to temporarily accept certification from CMDF and other service providers duly accredited by BWC that concerned AMOs have already enrolled in their forthcoming seminars and that corresponding seminar fees have been paid.

The Board also RESOLVED that certificate of course completion be submitted immediately after the course.
