Board Resolution No. 435, series of 2011

SEMINAR FOR ALL PROPRIETORS AND AMOS

WHEREAS, Section 20 of RA 4566 (the Contractor's License Law) requires that the proprietor/AMO of a construction firm must show knowledge of building, safety, health and lien laws of the Republic of the Philippines, among others;

WHEREAS, Joint Administrative Order No. 01, series of 2011 dated 29 April 2011 executed by and among the DOLE, DPWH, DTI, DILG and the PRC requires, among others, that the PCAB shall enhance the program of instilling a culture of safety among contractors and that all proprietors/AMOs shall undergo a safety and health orientation course as a requirement for the issuance of a contractor's license;

WHEREAS, the PCAB has formulated a syllabus for a seminar for proprietors/AMOs which includes safety and health in compliance with RA 4566 and Joint Administrative Order No. 01.

NOW, THEREFORE, based on the foregoing premises, PCAB RESOLVED to require all proprietors or AMOs to complete the seminar for proprietors/AMOs and submit proof of attendance thereto.


It is further RESOLVED that the completion of the AMO seminar will be pre-requisite to the filing of the renewal for CFY 2012-2013.
