



CIAP BOARD RESOLUTION NO. 03 Series of 2017

APPROVING THE CONCEPTUAL FRAMEWORK AND MECHANICS OF THE CONSTRUCTION INDUSTRY ONE REGISTRY SYSTEM (CIORS) AND ITS IMPLEMENTATION

WHEREAS, the Construction Industry Authority of the Philippines (CIAP), an attached agency of the Department of Trade and Industry (DTI), under Section 2 (a) of PD 1746 is tasked to promote, accelerate and regulate the growth and development of the construction industry in conformity with national goals;

WHEREAS, the Construction Manpower Development Foundation (CMDF) an implementing arm of CIAP has been mandated, among others to undertake manpower development programs for the construction sector as well as to draw up an overall construction manpower resource development plan and relevant strategies;

WHEREAS, in the CIAP 69th Regular Meeting held on 27 January 2015, the CMDF presented its Board Resolution No. 13, series of 2014 recommending to the CIAP Board the approval of the implementation of the Philippine Construction Human Resources Registry System (PCHRRS); **WHEREAS,** the CIAP Board, recognizing the importance of having a One Registry System of professionals and workers for the construction industry, passed CIAP Board Resolution Nos. 4, and 9 s. of 2015 during its 69th and 70th Regular Board Meetings held on 27 January 2015 and 22 September 2015, respectively;

WHEREAS, in the CIAP 70th Regular Meeting held on 22 September 2015, the Board reiterated that the one registry system shall serve as the repository of data of all workers (skilled and professionals) who have undergone a particular training program and certification of skills in the construction industry and agreed that CMDF shall lead the implementation;

WHEREAS, On 31 March 2016 during CIAP 71st Regular Meeting, the Board passed Resolution No. 02, s. 2016 creating the Technical Working Group (TWG) for the Construction Industry One Registry System (CIORS) that has been tasked to formulate the framework and mechanics of the One Registry.

WHEREAS, On 22 April 2016, CMDF convened the First Roundtable Discussion by the CIORS-TWG to discuss its value and initial conceptual framework;

WHEREAS, on 20 September and 15 November 2016, CMDF, likewise held the CIORS Workshops participated in by the stakeholders from both the public and private construction sectors to draw the conceptual framework and guidelines for consideration of the CMDF Board;

WHEREAS, in the CMDF Regular Meeting held on 29 November 2016, the Board passed CMDF Board Resolution No. 6 Series of 2016 recommending the CIORS Conceptual Framework and Mechanics for approval of the CIAP Board;

WHEREAS, in the CMDF Regular Meeting held on 29 November 2016, the Board passed CMDF Board Resolution No. 6 Series of 2016 recommending the CIORS Conceptual Framework and Mechanics for approval of the CIAP Board:

WHEREAS, the CIAP Board also noted that the CIORS will be the mechanism for validation of the competency of construction personnel; as well as serve as a policy and research tool and as reference for job matching in the construction industry, among others.

WHEREAS, during the 73rd CIAP Regular Meeting held on 12 January 2017, CMDF presented the final conceptual framework and mechanics to the Board for its approval.

NOW, THEREFORE, for and in consideration of the foregoing premises, the CIAP in its 73rd Regular Meeting held on 12 January 2017, RESOLVES as it is hereby RESOLVED. approving the Construction Industry One Registry System (CIORS) conceptual framework and mechanics. The Board FURTHER RESOLVES, for the CMDF to implement the CIORS.
