



CIAP BOARD RESOLUTION NO. 8 SERIES OF 2017

REINFORCING THE CONSTRUCTION INDUSTRY WORKFORCE THROUGH THE REVITALIZATION OF CONSTRUCTION MANPOWER DEVELOPMENT FOUNDATION (CMDF) MANPOWER DEVELOPMENT PROGRAMS

WHEREAS, the Construction Manpower Development Foundation (CMDF) an implementing arm of the Construction Industry Authority of the Philippines (CIAP) has been mandated, among others, to undertake manpower development programs for the construction sector as well as to draw up an overall construction manpower resource development plan and relevant strategies;

WHEREAS, with the "Golden Age of Infrastructure;" it is important to have competitive and competent human resources to continuously provide the essential drive and support for the construction industry to move forward;

WHEREAS, In several CIAP Board meetings, discussions ensued on the difficultly of producing enough trained and certified construction professionals and skilled workers, and the need to upgrade their skills and competencies to be domestically and globally competitive;

WHEREAS, in the CIAP 73rd Regular Meeting held on 12 January 2017, the Board finds the critical role of CMDF in manpower development and encouraged CMDF to improve the competitiveness and efficiency of the construction workers whether skilled or professionals, as well as adopt strategies to accelerate the development, including but not limited to, measures for upgrading professional, technical, and financial capabilities of all workers;

NOW THEREFORE, for and in consideration of the foregoing premises, the CIAP Board **RESOLVES** as it is **HEREBY RESOLVED**, to reinforce the construction workforce through a revitalized Construction Manpower Development Foundation Programs on manpower development of skilled labor and professionals workers. The Board **FURTHER RESOLVED**, to instruct CMDF Secretariat to submit a proposed revitalized manpower development Program to the CMDF Board for their discussion and endorsement to the CIAP Board for approval.
