

INVITATION TO APPLY FOR ELIGIBILITY AND TO BID FOR THE PROCUREMENT OF SECURITY SERVICES

1. The Construction Industry Authority of the Philippines (CIAP) through the GAA for FY 2021 intends to apply the sum of Three Million Seven Hundred Thirty- Nine Thousand Pesos (Php3,739,000.00) being the ABC to payments under the contract for the procurement of Security Service for CIAP Makati and CMDFTC Cavite for FY 2021. Bids in excess of the ABC shall automatically be rejected at the bid opening.
2. The Construction Industry Authority of the Philippines (CIAP) invites bids for the above Procurement Project. Delivery of the Security Services is required for the period of six months for the year 2021 from July to December 2021. Bidders should have completed, within three (3) years for the date of submission and receipt of bids, a contract similar to the Project. The description of eligible bidder is contained in the Bidding Documents, particularly in Section II (Instruction to Bidders).
3. Bidding documents will be conducted through open competitive bidding procedures using a non-Discretionary "pass/fail" criterion as specified in the 2016 Implementing Rules and Regulations (IRR) of Republic Act (RA) No. 9184.

Bidding is restricted to Filipino citizens/sole proprietorships, partnerships or organizations with at least sixty percent (60%) interest of outstanding capital stock belonging to citizens of the Philippines and to citizens or organizations of a country the laws and regulations of which grant similar rights or privileges to the Filipino citizens, pursuant to RA No. 5183.

4. Prospective bidders may obtain further information from CIAP and inspect the Bidding Documents at the address given below during Monday to Friday except holiday 8:00 A.M. to 5:00 P.M.
5. A complete set of Bidding Documents may be acquired by interested Bidders on May 21- June 10, 2021 from given address and websites below and upon payment of Three Thousand Seven Hundred Thirty Nine Pesos (P3,739.00), the applicable fee for the Bidding Documents, pursuant to the latest Guidelines issued by GPPB.

The Procuring Entity shall allow the bidder to present its proof of payment for fees in person, by facsimile or through electronic means.

6. The CIAP will hold a **Pre-Bid Conference on May 28, 2021 at 1:00 P.M.** through online /Video conferencing which shall be open to prospective bidders.
7. All bids must be accompanied by a bid security in any of acceptable forms and in the amount stated in the ITB Clause 14
8. **Deadline for the submission** of the eligibility requirements, technical and financial proposals will be on **June 10, 2021, 9:00 A.M.** and **opening of bids** will be on **June 10, 2021 10:00 A.M** at the CIAC Conference Room, Executive Building Center, 369 Sen. Gil J. Puyat Avenue Cor. Makati Ave., Makati City. and/ or via Online/video conferencing. Bid will be opened in the presence of the bidder's representative who choose to attend the activity.

The CIAP Bids and Awards Committee will not entertain late bidders.

9. A post-qualification of the bidder with the lowest calculated bid shall be conducted to verify, validate and ascertain the compliance of the said bidder with the legal, technical and financial requirements.

10. The CIAP reserves the right to reject any or all bids or any part thereof, declare a failure of bidding or not to award the contract at any time prior to award of contract in accordance with Section 35 and 41 of the 2016 revised IRR of RA 9184, without thereby incurring any liability to the affected bidder or bidders..
