TERMS OF REFERENCE

Procurement of Meals and Rental of Venue for the DTI – FIDIC Memorandum of Understanding Signing Ceremony of Philippine Overseas and Domestic Construction Board - Construction Industry Authority of the Philippines

I. Background and Rationale

The Philippine Overseas and Domestic Construction Board ("PODCB") of the Construction Industry Authority of the Philippines ("CIAP") promotes the interest of the Philippine construction industry in overseas markets to increase and sustain the export of Philippine-made construction materials and equipment, and technical, managerial, and highly professional construction services.

Under the Globalization pillar of the Philippine Construction Industry Roadmap 2020- 2030, the POCB drives and monitors the implementation of the Roadmap Action Plan on Construction Services, Exports, and Outsourcing Plan advocating the government's support for construction firms to strategically plan, build, and scale capabilities for providing engineering, procurement, and construction (EPC) services. This includes educating and capacitating industry stakeholders on internationally accepted standard contracts e.g., the International Federation of Consulting Engineers (FIDIC) contracts, contract drafting, management and administration, and developing negotiation skills for global competitiveness and increased viability to undertake overseas projects.

Meanwhile, FIDIC is partnering with key industry players in promoting the FIDIC forms of contract and in educating stakeholders on how contract provisions affect the efficient implementation of construction projects, especially big-ticket projects, and how to avoid and resolve disputes. With all these advocacies and goals aligned with the construction industry's goals of developing the capacity of local industry players, the PODCB proposes to ratify the partnership with FIDIC through an MOU. The MOU aims to familiarize and train constituents on FIDIC contracts which are the most widely used form of contract around the world.

II. Participants

The event will be attended by **60 persons** from Philippine Overseas and Domestic Construction Board (PODCB), FIDIC, Department of Trade and Industry (DTI), Department of Public Works and Highways (DPWH), Department of Transportation (DOTr) and the DTI Press Corps.

III. Specifications

A venue with the following technical specifications taking into consideration the rating factors under Annex "H: of the Revised Implementing Rules and Regulations of R.A. No. 9184 for Lease of Venue:

A. Availability. Venue must be available on the proposed schedule September 15, 2023, or on another schedule set by the end-user.

B. Location and Site Condition

- a. Accessibility. Located within Makati City.
- Parking Space. Provision of parking space at least ten percent (10%) from the guaranteed guests.
- Permits. Establishment must possess all necessary accreditations and permits required by the national and local government.

C. Neighborhood Data

a. Must have sanitation and health condition license/permit



 Accessible to police and fire stations, restaurants, banking and/or postal services

D. Venue

- a. Structural Condition. Must be in a good and well-maintained building facility.
- b. Functionality
 - i. Space Requirement. Conference / function room that can accommodate at least 50 persons (round table-type arrangement) with social distancing in accordance with COVID-19 safety and health protocols.
 - ii. Function Room / Conference Room. One (1) Air-conditioned conference/function room. Can accommodate at least 50 persons (round table-type arrangement) with the following specifications and/or requirements:

Room availability:

- Event Proper: 15 September 2023 from 9:00 AM to 1:00 PM
- Ingress and Technical Dry Run*: 15 September 2023 from 7:30 AM –
 9:00 AM
 - *Free of charge (Ingress / Egress)

Provision of the following:

- · Sound/audio system with at least two (2) microphones
- LCD projector and screen
- High-speed internet connection
- Notepad and pencils
- iii. Light, ventilation and air conditioning. With good lighting and well-ventilated function/conference room.
- iv. Facilities. Well maintained building/facilities such as: water supply and with access to bathroom facilities; lighting system; fire escapes; firefighting equipment; Internet and telecommunications; audio visual equipment and microphone requirements.

v. Other requirements.

- Maintenance. As stated above.
- Attractiveness/Cleanliness. With pleasing/appealing view and resort/building facilities
- Security. With visible security personnel
- Not listed as Quarantine Facility by the Department of Health or Bureau of Quarantine

E. Food

- a. The following requirements shall be provided:
 - Free-flowing coffee and tea, with provision for water station, throughout the conference / function room.
 - · AM Snacks for 50 pax
 - · Buffet lunch for 60 pax
 - Must comply with the existing IATF Guidelines on dine-in services of food preparation establishments.



IV. Approved Budget for the Contract

The Approved Budget for the Contract (ABC) is **PhP 275,000.00** inclusive of all applicable government taxes and service charges.

V. Mode of Procurement

The procurement shall be undertaken through Negotiated Procurement – Lease of Real Property and Venue pursuant to R.A. No. 9184 and its 2016 revised Implementing Rules and Regulations (IRR).

VI. Evaluation and Selection Criteria (Rating Scheme)

Bid proposals shall be evaluated following the criteria prescribed under Annex "H" of the Revised Implementing Rules and Regulations of R.A. No. 9184. In addition, the service provider should attach to its bid proposal a filled-out Bidder's Statement of Compliance (Annex A) of this document.

VII. Payment Scheme

The agreed payment scheme with the Service Provider is Send Bill Agreement. If the Service Provider has no Landbank of the Philippines account, payment shall be released through Modified Disbursement Scheme (MDS) Check.

VIII. Liquidated Damages

If the service provider fails to delivery any or all of the goods and/or to perform the services within the period specified in this Terms of Reference, the Procuring Entity shall, without prejudice to its remedies under this contract and under the applicable law, deduct form the contract price as liquidated damages, the applicable rate of one-tenth (1/10) of one percent (1%) of the cost of the unperformed portion of every day of delay. Pursuant to Section 68 of R.A. No. 9184, the maximum deduction shall be ten percent (10%) of the amount of the contract. Once the maximum is reached, the Procuring Entity reserves the right to rescind the contract, without prejudice to other courses of action and remedies open to it.

IX. Dispute Resolution Agreement/Resolution

- Should there be any dispute related to the contract and/or rights of the parties, the same shall be submitted to mutual consultation, mediation and arbitration, in order of application. The venue of proceedings shall be in Makati City.
- 2. In case of a court suit, the venue shall be courts of competent jurisdiction in Makati City, to the exclusion of all other courts.
